GO Ministries thrives because of mutually transformational, international partnerships.

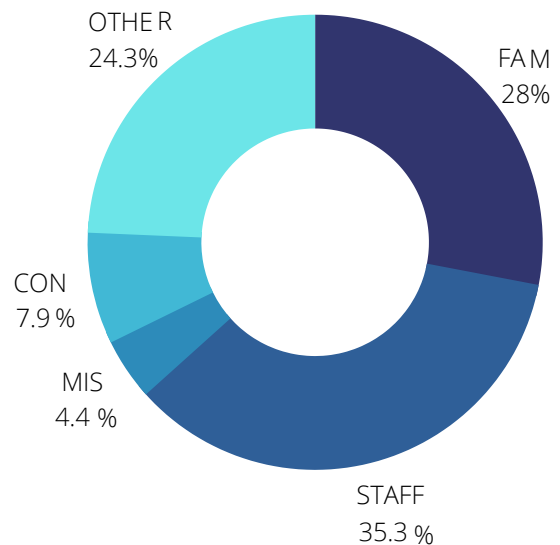
**In 2021, we hosted 21 short terms teams, who served alongside missionaries and local leaders across our four FAMs.**

- Other: \$1,409,189

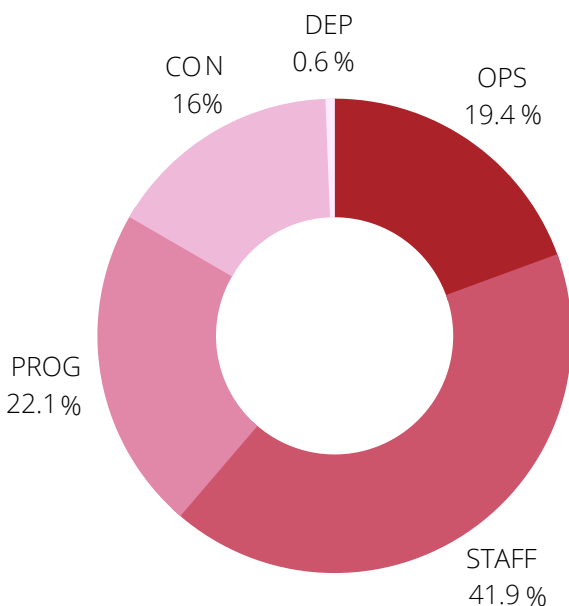

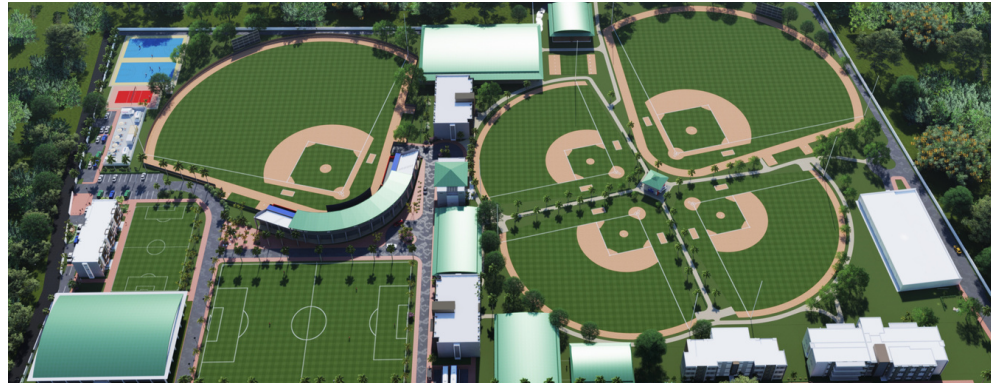
