

## 2025 At a Glance

This year, we were excited to host teams in Argentina for the very first time!

In total, more than **1,550** team members served in both Argentina and the Dominican Republic. These volunteers came from **33** different states and represented a wide range of ages—from **3 to 78** years old.

Here are a few highlights of the impact delivered by our teams:

- More **than 100** Field Days and **50** Vacation Bible Schools were hosted in local communities.
- **35+** medical clinics were held across the Santiago area, providing essential care to those in need.
- Over **170 homes** were painted, creating meaningful opportunities for local pastors to demonstrate the love of Jesus in practical, visible ways.
- More than **35 concrete floors** were poured, giving families safer, cleaner living conditions and reducing exposure to disease and dirt.
- A **basketball court** and a **volleyball court** were completed in communities around Santiago, offering teenagers a safer place to gather - and creating opportunities for meaningful discipleship.
