Transforming

I am currently a mom to 4 teenagers (13, 15, 17, 19). I'm not sure 4 teens in the house has ever been "easy" no matter the time or place in which you have lived. However, I feel that this generation is under attack more intensely than what we have seen in recent memory.

Most of American teens are now disciples of the internet. Snapchat, Instagram, Facebook, and YouTube are full of energy 24/7 with which they feed into our youth. And it is no longer a secret that the companies behind these platforms do not have the well being of this generation in mind.

I spent the first 10 days of this month in the Dominican Republic. 8 of those days I spent with 20 teenagers as they mostly

unplugged from their devices and experienced a culture and place other than what they were used to. In many ways they are a captive audience! For 8 days they break free from their norm.

What I love about bringing teenagers to a place with limited cell reception is that most of them fall into this new rhythm easily. They talk to friends when they want to talk, they nap in the bus when they are tired, and they **see** what is around them.

There is plenty to see in a new place. Unfamiliar surroundings are such a feast for all of your senses. Our minds are trying to make sense of all the things that are uncommon in our day to day.



This was my fourth time leading a teen trip to the DR. What always astounds them is the **joy** they see around them. I think it's interesting that this is what stands out to them the most. Of course, they are surprised that people with little can have joy. However, I think the other reason they notice this is there is such little **joy** in our culture.

Eight days is not a long time. But it does give these kids time to see another way. Different priorities, different food, a different culture.

A different way to live. A fuller way to live.

Your prayers & financial support enable me to be a part of taking 100 teams a year out of the country. I'm not physically present for each of these teams but the same thing is happening. For 8 days they are no longer disciples of the internet. They are apprentices of missionaries and local pastors. They see God working in ways they haven't seen before.

Now, a mission trip is not a requirement for spiritual growth and it is not a guarantee of a certain outcome. However, it sticks with them forever. It is a turning point. I was on the bus when one teen boy looked at another teen boy and said "you changed my life". He hadn't ever been loved for who he was and he found that. That sticks with you.

No, I can't "guarantee results" but I have full confidence in these words...

Philippians 1:6 And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus Returns.
