COME AND SEE

Throughout the Gospels, when people questioned Jesus or struggled to understand what He was doing, His response was often simple: “come and see.” There are moments when explanation falls short, and the clearest invitation is to walk alongside, to witness firsthand, and to experience what words alone cannot convey.

This truth became especially meaningful to me when my oldest daughter, Annie, had the opportunity to come to the Dominican Republic this month. She joined a team that was taking medical clinics to communities where we provide free basic medical care. In her few days there, she experienced the ministry up close. Sharing that time together was a profound gift for both of us. As a

missionary who travels several times each year, the demands of the work can place strain on family life. Inviting my children to “come and see” the work firsthand transforms those sacrifices into shared purpose.

Annie’s visit also reminded me that the opportunity to “come and see” what God is doing through the global Church is a gift available to every believer. When we step into another community and witness faith lived out in a different context, our perspective widens and our understanding of God’s heart deepens.

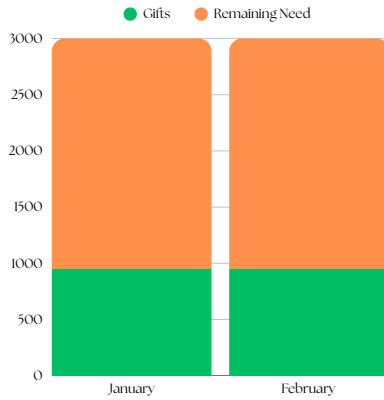
I read a study this past week suggesting that people are more likely to make significant life pivots after a profound travel experience than after years of traditional therapy. There is something powerful about stepping outside the rhythms of daily life and truly seeing how others live—the pace, the priorities, and the deep joy present across cultures. Such experiences have a way of reshaping what we value and clarifying what matters most.

One phrase you hear again and again on a trip with GO Ministries is “mutual transformation.” Of course, we hope our American team members will make a meaningful impact during their time here. But our vision reaches beyond what happens in a single week of service.
